Our firm represents defendant Maria A. Patrizio, Esq. s/h/a Atty. Maria Petrizio in this matter, and we are writing to the Court in response/opposition to plaintiff's letter dated December 26, 2012 in which he asks the Court to order discovery in this action, and he makes reference to a recent hearing on December 14, 2012 in Orange County Family Court at which he was "not allowed" to attend.

It is our understanding that Mr. Teitelbaum was not barred by any court order from attending this hearing. Furthermore, we understand that a permanency neglect trial is scheduled for January 17, 2013 in Orange County Family Court.
