Dear Judge Briccetti,

I am Jacob Teitelbaum, Plaintiff in this action. I was recently served with a motion for dismissal, by Defendant David Rubenstein, filed on December 18th, and returnable by January 3th 2013.

As of today almost all Defendants have filed their motions for dismissal quite some time ago, and their replies to my answer. But, Defendant David Rubenstein claims he never received the Amended Complaint, and based on previous Court ruling on July 2th, and July 31th "that the time for any defendant to answer or move is stayed to answer or move is stayed pending their receipt of service of the amended complaint".


Since Plaintiff was granted *in forma pauperis*, the U S Marshals were ordered to serve the Defendants with the original Complaint, and the Amended Complaint, and according to the Marshals Defendant David Rubenstein was served with the Amended Complaint on June 29th (Doc 36), and on July 30th at the Court's request (Doc 40), accordingly Plaintiff made every effort to timely serve Defendant David Rubenstein.

Therefore I respectfully ask the Hon. Court to dismiss Defendant Rubenstein's Motion to Dismiss, or, in the alternative, to extend the time to serve Defendant David Rubenstein with the Amended Complaint, and order the U S Marshals to serve him again, despite the fact the Marshalls assert that he was already served.

I would also ask the Hon. Court to extend the time to file my opposition papers for the rest of the motions to dismiss until the January 31th 2013, with the Defendant filing his reply by February 28th 2013, In order to be able to prepare and draft my opposition papers properly.
