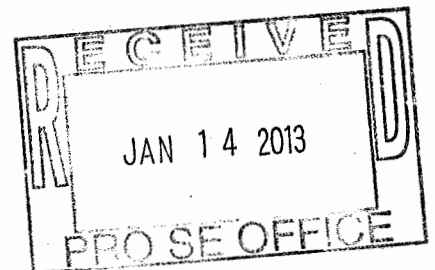




MOTION FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT

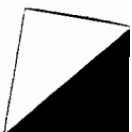

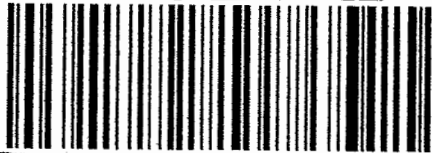

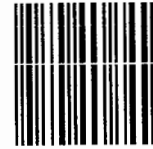
