moved to dismiss the Second Amended Complaint (Docs. #190, 198, 208), and,

Whereas the matter having come before the Honorable Vincent L. Briccetti, United States  
District Judge, and the Court, on July 2, 2013, having handed down its Memorandum Decision (Doc.  
#233) denying Plaintiff's various Motions and granting Defendants' Motions to dismiss, it is,

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:** That, for the reasons stated in the  
Court's Memorandum Decision, dated July 2, 2013, Plaintiff's Motions (Docs. #171, 172, 211, 223,  
and 227) are denied; Defendants' Motions (Docs. #190, 198, and 208) are granted and Plaintiff's

claims against all Defendants are dismissed with prejudice; accordingly, the case is closed. Additionally, the Court certifies pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3) that any appeal from this order would not be taken in good faith, and therefore in forma pauperis status is denied for the purpose of an appeal.
